CodeMeter is one of the top 10 finalists for the Automation Award 2012 at SPS IPC Drives

Karlsruhe – For the first time ever CodeMeter from Wibu-Systems has been nominated one of the top 10 products by the jury of the German Automation Award 2012. CodeMeter is a premier technology designed to protect and license software in embedded systems.

Not only the executable code of the software is encrypted and digitally signed, but the license is either stored in a dongle or a file.
